



VOLUNTEER COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS

GOLF CARTS

Golf Carts volunteers oversee the charging, distribution and collection of carts to authorized personnel. Volunteers are also responsible for driving golf carts on the course to help shuttle players, volunteers and spectators.

MARSHALS + SPOTTERS

Marshals + Spotters are stationed in specific areas of the course, such as greens, tees and landing areas. These volunteers help locate golf balls manage crosswalk areas and ensure spectators are following appropriate golf etiquette.

PRACTICE AREA

Volunteers assist in providing and maintaining a suitable driving range for all players. Specific duties include maintaining supplies such as range balls, beverages and player + team identification signs.

SUPPLY DISTRIBUTION

Volunteers are responsible for distributing product such as water, soda and snacks throughout the course. This committee is physically demanding.

TELEVISION

Volunteers assist Golf Channel staff in the production of the telecast, serving as spotters and cart drivers. Substantial golf knowledge is recommended.

TRANSPORTATION

Volunteers are responsible for transporting players and volunteers to several locations throughout the golf course using shuttle vans. Please note, all volunteers for this committee must be 25 years of age or older.

VOLUNTEER SERVICES

Volunteers are responsible for staffing the Volunteer Center, managing uniform distribution and maintaining a comfortable working environment for the volunteers.

WALKING SCORERS

Each scorer follows a particular group, marking each stroke and specific statistics. At the end of each hole, these volunteers are responsible for entering scores into the GolfStat application via their personal smartphone. Training is provided, but golf knowledge is recommended. Volunteers should be able to walk 18 holes.
