HEALTH + SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

The health and safety of tournament volunteers is a top priority. As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, additional procedures will be implemented at the 2020 Blessings Collegiate Invitational to ensure measures are being taken to keep volunteers as safe as possible. All event plans have been communicated with the State of Arkansas Public Health Department and are in compliance with CDC guidelines. Please note, health + safety precautions are subject to change, and volunteers will be notified of any changes. HEALTH + SAFETY PROCEDURES

Volunteer Uniform Distribution

- Volunteer Uniform Pick-Up will take place in the parking lot across the street from Blessings Golf Club (5826 Clear Creek Blvd, Fayetteville, AR 72704) on Saturday, October 3. The event will be a drive-thru pick-up only as all uniforms will be pre-packed and volunteers will be asked to remain in their vehicles. The drive-thru pick-up will be open from 10:00am – 12:00pm and all staff distributing uniforms will be wearing masks.

Before You Arrive On-Site

- All volunteers are encouraged to review the CDC Self-Check Symptoms Page, found here: <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/>. If you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms please do not attend the tournament and seek medical advice.

Upon Arrival

- All volunteers will be required to park in the lot across the street from Blessings Golf Club. Police will be onsite to assist volunteers crossing the street in a safe manner.
- Please follow signage to the temperature screening area in the Clubhouse breezeway. Each volunteer **will receive a temperature screening** prior to entering the Volunteer Center. A daily wristband will be given to volunteers to indicate a passed screening.
- **The Volunteer Center will be located inside the Indoor Practice Facility**, and all volunteers will be required to check in at this location, only once the temperature screening has been passed.
- All volunteers will be **required to complete the Volunteer Medical Waiver** upon arrival for their first shift. The waiver will be available in the Volunteer Center.
- Upon check-in, **volunteers will receive a 'PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) Bag' each day** which will include disposable masks, gloves and sanitizing products.
- Once checked-in, **pre-packaged breakfast + lunch items will be available.**
- Golf cart shuttles will then be available to transport volunteers directly from Volunteer Center to their on-course locations as needed. **Masks are required to be worn on shuttle carts.**
- The Volunteer Center provides a space for volunteers to receive a beverage or snack, ask a question, and take a quick break if needed. However, **lounging and gathering in this area will not be permitted.**

GENERAL REMINDERS

- Masks and sanitation products will be provided to you each day. Please wear your mask at all times possible and when in close proximity to other individuals. Use sanitation products before and after touching objects or surfaces that other people will be in contact with.
